Section J Youth

The Youth section is split into school age groups, Nursery, Primary, Secondary school, except where stated below. All entries must have the age on the entry card, which are picked up when you place your entry in the Show. While there are some categories that younger children may need help with, there are many that children of all ages can tackle themselves. As an incentive, there are even prizes!

Your scarecrow can be any size, any shape and any animal or person, real or fictional. You could even make a group of scarecrows. Scarecrows are invited to the Show to be judged and there is a £5 prize for the best entry. Afterwards your scarecrow can return home with you.

- J11 "Animal Magic" animal made from Fruit, Vegetables, Foliage etc
- J12 Item Made of Lego

Miniature Garden (not to exceed 23 x 37cm),

- J13 age 3-5 years.
- J14 age 6-8 years.
- J15 age 9-11 years.

Most Amusing Craft Entry (Youth) gets a donated monetary gift (excluding animal magic).

Society prize: most points in each age group J1-J12

Horticulture (Veg & Fruit)

Each of the three sections is split into "Nursery and Primary" and "Secondary".

- J20 Any vegetable or plant
- J21 Basket of Plenty — a basket filled with fruit and vegetables, displayed in a decorative way.
- J22 Most amusing misshapen vegetable

Society prize: most points in each age group J20-J22

Floral

Here the imagination can run wild.

- J25 Arrangement in an unusual container
- J26 An arrangement in a mug

Society prize: most points in each age group J25-J26

Baking

Don't eat too many test products when practising!

Nursery and Primary school age

- J30 Four Iced Fairy Cakes
- J31 Four Uncooked Cakes, one variety
- J32 Edible Jewellery
- J33 Gingerbread Person

Secondary school age

- J36 Cake, minimum 15cms
- J37 Three decorated cup cakes
- J38 Four Biscuits (any variety)
- J39 Four Sweets (any variety)
